

## **Distancing Monitor**

A person assigned by each team to monitor the physical distancing of their own team's players, coaches, and spectators on and off the field.

## <u>Injury Attendant</u>

A person (could be a coach or manager or parent) who attends a softball activity and is the only person, besides the coach, that is designated to go onto the field if an injury occurs. Wherever possible this is preferred to be a person with first aid training.

In the event that first aid is required to be administered during an activity, all persons attending to the injured individual(s) must first put on a mask and gloves.
