



Screener

The Screener will be responsible for pre -screening of all participants and spectators attending a Facility (this does not include casual park users or others attending the Facility for purposes other than softball, only those who are attending the softball activities).

Before any individual is allowed to go onto the diamond, or engage in either softball activities, or to be there as a spectator, they must be screened to determine if they are permitted entry.

These questions must be answered by everyone and if they give a positive answer to any of the following questions, that person must be instructed to either return home, or to seek medical attention, but they are not allowed to attend the scheduled softball activities.

Screening questions are:

1. Are you exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat and/or painful swallowing, stuffy or runny nose, loss of sense of smell and/or taste, headache, muscle aches, fatigue, loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea)?
2. Has any member of your household exhibited any symptoms of COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
3. Have you had close contact with someone who has or is suspected to have COVID-19 or have you been told by public health that you may have been exposed and need to quarantine (self-isolate)?
4. Have you arrived from outside Canada in the past 14 days?
