

Safety and Sanitation Activity Protocol for LFA teams

Before Activity Begins

- a. Attendance Tracker & Screener (we suggest they are the same person) arrive at park first and set up at the ingress point. See <u>Ingress and Egress Maps by Park.</u>
 - i. Max 20 minutes before scheduled time.
 - ii. Screen every person who arrives and record their information on the TOL Attendance Tracker Sheet.
- b. Sanitation Champion checks in with Screener and Attendance Tracker. Then heads to equipment bin with Sanitation Bucket to gather rest of disinfecting supplies.
 - i. Disinfect any high-touch surfaces, including posts, bases, equipment bin.
 - ii. Make sure team hand sanitizer is in a visible spot for easy use.
- c. Injury Attendant makes sure they have gloves and masks available in case of injury.
- d. Players arrive at park ready to go, using the TOL ingress & egress plan to ensure physical distancing during arrival and departure, no more than 15 minutes before scheduled time.
 See Ingress and Egress Maps by Park.

Township of Langley Mandated Face Mask Usage:

- Coaches must wear a mask at all times.
- Participants, over the age of 12, must wear a mask off the field with the exception of:
 - i. People with health conditions or with physical, cognitive or mental impairments who cannot wear one;
 - ii. People who cannot put on or remove a mask on their own; or
 - iii. Any other exemption identified by the Emergency Program Act (EPA) mask mandate.
 - Masks are not required while participants are in active training. (on the field during practice.)

During Activity

- e. Attendance Tracker & Screener continues to monitor for new participants.
- f. There can be no more than 50 people in attendance.
- g. Sanitation Champion continues to make sure participants are using hand sanitizer on a regular basis. They also make sure shared equipment is sanitized after every drill or during water breaks.
- Distancing Monitor makes sure participants and spectators are maintaining their distance from each other. 3 meters during activity and 2 meters transitioning to and from the field.

After Activity

- Attendance Tracker takes a photo of Attendance sheet for the activity and emails it to the LFA Attendance Coordinator at <u>lfafields@gmail.com</u>. It is also to be sent to <u>covid-</u> <u>attendance@tol.ca</u> by LFA.
- j. Sanitation Champion uses diamond disinfectant to clean high touch surfaces, including team equipment. Gathers rest of sanitation supplies and places into Sanitation Bucket.
 - i. Sanitation Champion emails <u>operationslfa@gmail.com</u> if any of the supplies are running low.
- k. Everyone is to be out of the park 15 minutes after the scheduled end of the activity. See <u>Ingress and Egress Maps by Park.</u>
